During the year, points are given for the two highest scoring images or prints in each of the club's competitions and then totalled up after all the competitions have finished. The competitions are a mixture of prints and digital images, colour and monochrome, with this year's set subjects of Pairs and Contrast, where Members can be as creative as they like.

Kevin is thrilled, *"I knew some of my images had done well during the year but I had no idea I would be winning this club accolade. I'm really pleased to receive the award from WGPS and will be busy taking more images over the summer ready for next season's competitions."*
